Preparedness Memory

Directions:

1. Print the picture pages.
2. Carefully cut the pictures from the pages.

Game Instructions:

1. Turn the cards face down on a flat surface (i.e., a desk, the floor or the kitchen table) and mix them up.
2. Arrange the cards into rows.
3. *Time to play!* ... turn over any two cards.
4. If the cards match, the player keeps the pair and flips two new cards.
5. If the cards do not match, the cards are turned face down, and the next player goes.
6. The game continues until all the cards are matched.
7. The player with the most matches wins.
